DRESS APPROPRIATELY

Clean and neat attire are a must for any job interview. Try on your outfit ahead of time and make sure everything fits.



PRACTICE GREETING

Practice greeting your interviewer. The best way to greet your interview is with a friendly smile and a firm handshake.



RESEARCH & PREPARE

Research the company. Refresh your memory on the background of the company and think about some potential answers.



PRESENTATION

Make sure your hair is tidy. You don't have to cut your hair or shave your beard, however it helps to present yourself appropriately.

DON'T
